

MA IN CULTURAL AND SOCIAL ANTHROPOLOGY (TAUGHT IN BULGARIAN)

Brief presentation of the program: The program is research-oriented and offers specialized knowledge of the diversity of human societies and cultures. Students will acquire knowledge from different fields of Anthropology (economic, political, symbolic) and acquire skills for a comparative study of cultures and societies in Europe, the Black Sea and the Balkans. The training program goes through specialized courses in Anthropology of Europe and Eurasia, construction of cultural and national identity, cultural memory, cross-border mobility and globalization processes, regionalization methodology of anthropological research. In extracurricular training of students the focusing is on conducting anthropological fieldwork observations and development of research projects. On their own field research is based and the preparation of a Master's thesis.
