Brief presentation of the program: Training in the program during the first two years covers general education; training in basic scientific directions in two-semester courses: Science of language, The science of literature, Historical knowledge, Mythology and Religion, History of Bulgaria, Aesthetics and art theory, General History of art; general education courses in humanities, philology and cultural studies. During the third and fourth year training is organized in specialized courses in the program and extracurricular learning modes. In the fourth year the program offers two specializations that lead to professional qualifications.
